Hello Students and Parents of the Mulholland MS Music Classes!

Normally we would be in a Band class, a Guitar class, or an Orchestra class, but due to our current situation, those classes will not be happening at this time. Instead we will be preparing for those classes by doing a music history class that will include learning about all the different instruments that you will have the opportunity to play at Mulholland MS (MMS), once we return to school and it is deemed safe to do those types of activities in the classroom.

Course Overview

This class will focus on students developing an appreciation for music, including different styles, periods and cultures. Expectations

Assignments will all be done through Schoology, and using a variety of mediums, including videos, internet research, etc. You will log in to your Zoom class at the start of each period, we will go over the week's assignments, and then you will be able to then complete your assignments after the Zoom class has ended.

Grading

I grade on a straight percentage scale, so 90% and up is an A, 80-89% is a B, 70-79% is a C, 60-69% is a D, and anything below 59% is a Fail.
